Curriculum Newsletter - Year 6

ENGLISH

Spring Term 1, the children will continue using the vehicle text 'Hansel and Gretel to write a persuasive letter. Our class reciprocal reading text will be 'The Explorer'.

Spring Term 2, the children will be using the vehicle text 'Shackletons Journey' to write an endurance narrative and a magazine article. .

MATHS

Spring Term 1: Continue with fractions including solving problems involving the four operations. Geometry (Position and Direction) including full coordinate grid and translation, rotation and reflection., decimals

Spring Term 2:Percentages, algebra, measurement, ratio . We will also be preparing for Sats in May.

SCIENCE

Spring Term 1 and 2: Animals including humans. Children will:

- * Identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system, and explain the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood
- * Recognise the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function
- * Describe the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans.

Spring Term will focus on investigations (SC1).

Spring Term 1: Exploring mass (6.3) – children will learn about the different parts of the Mass, particularly the Liturgy of the Eucharist. They will learn about the first Passover

Spring Term 2: Jesus, the Messiah (6.4) Children will learn that the miracles Jesus performed led many to believe that Jesus was Gods son
