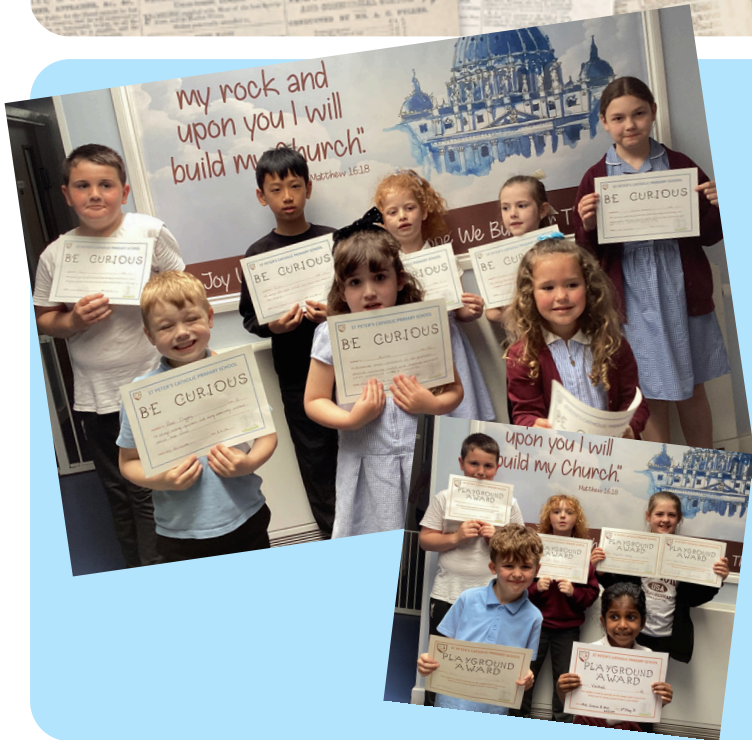

You need to check the hair for lice at least twice a week, every week



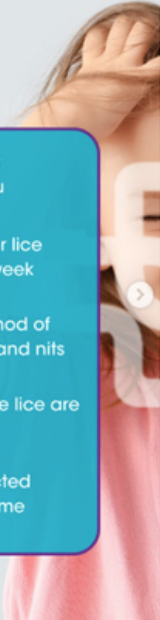
Wet-Combing is the best method of detecting and removing lice and nits
