

## St Peter's Catholic Primary School Curriculum Overview EYFS 2019-2020

Personal, Social & Emotional Development	<ul> <li>Building confidence to choose activities and discuss ideas</li> <li>Build awareness of needing help, and confidence to ask</li> <li>Confidence to speak in a group of familiar peers</li> <li>Working as part of a group, following rules where appropriate</li> <li>Forming positive relationships with peers and adults</li> <li>Playing co-operatively, taking turns</li> </ul>
English	<ul> <li>Use phonics to decode straightforward words</li> <li>Read simple sentences</li> <li>Discuss what has been read</li> <li>Use phonics knowledge to write simple words and sentences</li> <li>Read and write some irregular words</li> </ul>
Maths	<ul> <li>Count reliably with numbers up to 20</li> <li>Use counting on and number knowledge for simple addition</li> <li>Begin to recognise and describe simple patterns</li> <li>Use everyday language to talk about size, position, time, etc.</li> <li>Use mathematical language to describe shapes and objects</li> </ul>
Communicatio n & Language	<ul> <li>Listening attentively, including while completing tasks</li> <li>Listening to stories and responding to prompts and ideas</li> <li>Following instructions to carry out activities</li> <li>Expression of ideas, including real-life and fictional ideas</li> <li>Using past, present and future forms of language</li> </ul>
Physical Development	<ul> <li>Developing control and coordination of movement</li> <li>Handling equipment and tools, including for writing</li> <li>Learning about healthy diet and exercise</li> <li>Managing their own hygiene and personal needs</li> </ul>
Understanding the World	<ul> <li>Talk about events in their own lives and that of their family</li> <li>Know about similarities and differences between communities</li> <li>Talk about similarities and differences between objects</li> <li>Make observations of plants and animals</li> <li>Recognise that technology is used in homes and schools</li> </ul>
Expressive Art & Design	<ul> <li>Experiment with songs, music and dance</li> <li>Use a range of artistic materials, tools and techniques</li> <li>Work imaginatively to create new works</li> <li>Represent ideas through art, music, role-play, dance and stories</li> </ul>
