HELPING OTHERS

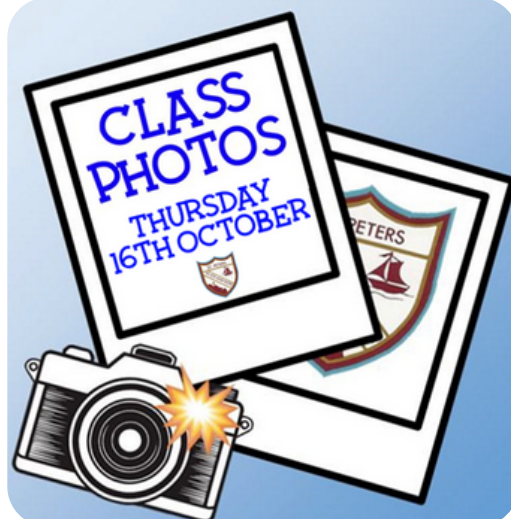

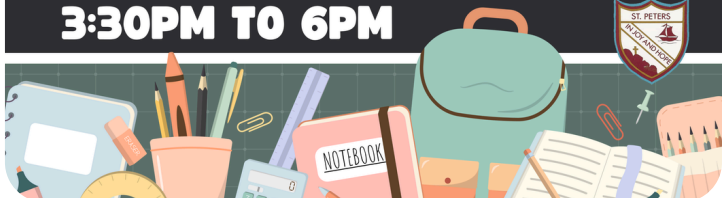
