| Artist | A person who creates paintings or drawings as a profession or hobby. |
| Margret Godfrey | An award winning watercolor artist. Margaret shares her enthusiasm for watercolor through teaching and exhibiting her art in shows. |
| Acrylic paint | A fast-drying paint made of pigment suspended in acrylic. |
| Representation | The description or portrayal of someone or something in a particular way. |
| Composition | Composition is the way in which different elements of an artwork are combined or arranged. |
