ENGLISH

In English we will be looking at fiction, books. We will be reading together in groups, individually and as a class. We will be focusing on making predictions of what may happen next. Children will also plan and create their own diaries, using vocabulary to create interest. We will also be studying biographies and looking at other non-fiction texts.

MATHS

We will look at:
Place Value
Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
Statistics.
Area and perimeter.

SCIENCE

In Science our topic is 'Animals including humans'. Children will discover how animals differ, looking closely at digestion. We will also investigate habitats and look to classify animals.

R.E.

We will initially be studying the Bible and the stories within it. We will also look at Trusting God.

COMPUTING

In computing we will discuss E-safety. We will also use computers to research.

P.E.

In P.E. we will be practising skills needed for ball games and explore dance.

OTHER TOPICS

(MUSIC, HISTORY & GEOGRAPHY, D.T./ART, PHSE)

- We will be studying the Shang Dynasty and explore Time zones.
- In Art and D.T we will be studying architecture, creating clay objects and developing our general art techniques.
- We will practice our singing, playing and composing every week using the Charanga music program. We will also compose our own musical pieces and analyse and evaluate well know pieces of music from all genres.
- We will talk about new beginnings and friendships.
- We will further develop our French.
