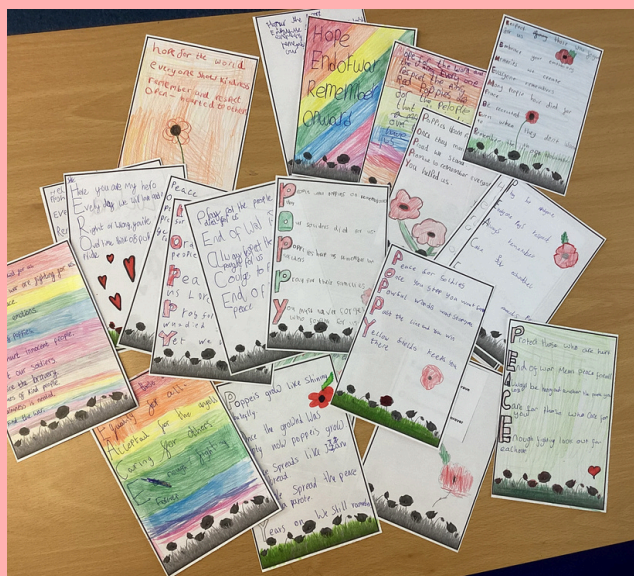


Its been another busy week in our Curriculum Clubs. Our pupils have loved taking part.

ACROSTIC POEM

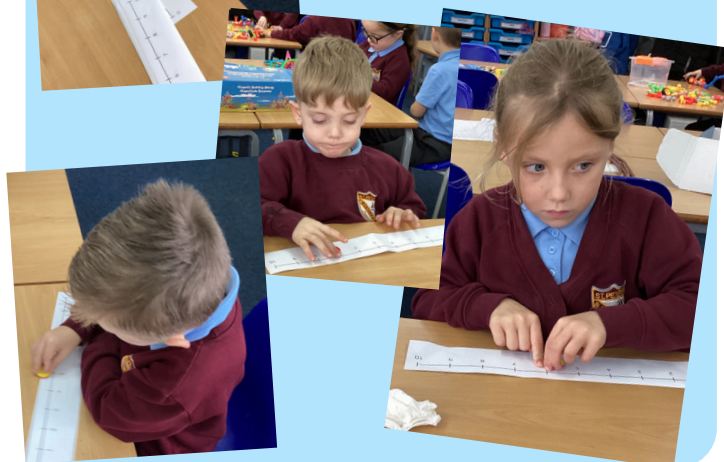


Year 5 have been creating acrostic poems for Remembrance day this week. Each one used the word 'Poppy' and made a collection of beautiful pieces of work.

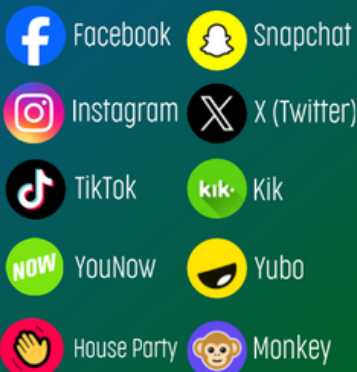

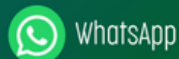

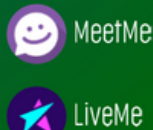
